BAPTISMAL APPLICATION The First Reformed Church, Pompton Plains, New Jersey

Background:

"The Constitution of the Reformed Church in America" (Article 9, Section 4) states that "The Sacrament of Baptism shall be administered if possible at a time and place of public worship. The office for the Administration of the Sacrament must be read." Except for good reasons, Baptism shall be administered in the Church. Parents or guardians must be present to assume the vows. The Church prohibits the practice of others assuming the vows for the parents or the guardians.

The teaching of the Reformed Church concerning the nature of baptism and the taking of the vows by the parents presupposes that of at least one of them be a communicant member of the Christian Church." (From LITURGY & PSALMS, p. 26)
